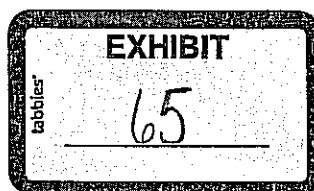
CHAPTER 7

ORDER GRANTING
